



4-H Ontario Day Camp Grant

Purpose of the Grant Program

4-H Ontario is dedicated to offering positive development activities for youth across the province. We do this by providing support to 4-H volunteers to deliver quality programs where youth learn and play. As 4-H Ontario explores options to engage more non-traditional audiences, we are piloting a new program to engage youth on their days off school. 4-H Ontario wishes to introduce youth who are not currently involved in 4-H to learn what 4-H has to offer. This grant program was created to provide support to 4-H volunteers who wish to hold a day camp during out of school time (i.e. on a teacher's professional development (PD) day, Christmas Break or March Break, etc.). Day camps are typically offered for youth ages 6 -12, which is why the Discovery Day provincial opportunities are offered for this age group.

Grant Criteria:

1. Hold a day camp during out of school time
2. Welcome youth (4-H members and non-members) between the ages of 6-12 (or any span within this age group)
3. Follow 4-H Ontario policies and procedures (Volunteers In Good Standing, Chaperones, Participant Agreement Form, etc.)

4-H Ontario will provide:

- 6 grants of \$500 each (ideally one per region, but multiple requests from one region may be considered if there are not requests from all regions)
- 2018 Discovery Days curriculum can be provided for use by volunteers at this event
- Non-perishable supplies used for the 2018 Discovery Days curriculum that are shippable and not previously booked, upon request (for example, a parachute)

4-H Association will need to:

- Provide perishable supplies (for example: food stuff, craft supplies, etc.)
- Coordinating logistics, overseeing the day and supervising youth attendees, gathering Participant Agreement Forms, and any other supplies required
- Report back to 4-H Ontario on your day camp (more details on the report once grant is awarded. This will be helpful in reporting back to the funder for this opportunity).
- Acknowledge Beef Farmers of Ontario when advertising and running your event

REMEMBER: This grant opportunity is open to all 4-H Associations. 4-H Ontario would ideally like to provide one per region, but multiple requests from one region may be considered if there are not requests from all regions.
