



# Tips & Tricks

## Agriculture Projects

### Eat & Support Local

Get in the kitchen to cook and bake new recipes with whole food ingredients. Try to incorporate local ingredients when possible.

### Food Security & Access

Have important conversations with members about how not everyone has access to proper food in nutrition in the world, and at home in our own communities too. Consider running a food drive!

### Focus on Industry Standards

Talk about the regulations and processes in place for producers and farmers in Canada.

### Planting at Home

Have members start seedlings at home and take care of them over the span of the project getting them to the point of planting them outdoors by achievement day.

### Documentaries

There are many documentaries around food, agriculture and the environment. Share clips with members to help facilitate grip discussion around these hot topics.

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### Club Material Kits

Consider creating kits of meeting supplies that members can receive before the meeting. Organize a social distanced drop-off or pick-up of materials.

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### Virtual Pet Show

Have a pet meet and greet on your next zoom call. Have members share their pets name, age, species and show a trick they do!

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### Agriulture Product Search

Have members look around their homes to identify non-food items that are products of the agriculture industry.

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### Agri-Tourism

Talk about what Agri-tourism is and what that looks like around the world. Search for virtual Agri-tourism experiences to participate in or have members design an agritourism event or location.

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### Live Demonstrations & Tours

Wherever possible try to have volunteers or guests' speakers take members behind the sciences to see processes and content in action. For example - plant identification from the field or honey extraction.
