## Arts & Crafts Projects

### Digital Crafting

Try something new and have members create online. Explore graphic design, creating photobooks or phot editing.

### Find Inspiration Outdoors

Encourage members to get outside and find inspiration for an upcoming project. For example: draw a building in your town or find patterns in nature.

### Socialize While You Work

There may be some lulls as members work away independently on their projects, we encourage you to ask questions, trivia or play an ice breaker to fill the silence.

### Join Pinterest

Pinterest is a great website to find new ideas for projects. We recommend making a board for all the projects you'd like to try in your 4-H club.

### Member Led Activities

Members have many talents, have them lead activities where they can display their skills and talents.

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### Resourceful Materials

Have members find materials around their home. Challenge them to make something with items in their recycling bin. Or incorporate crafts using nature.

### Host a Paint Night

Bring in an instructor (or find a video online) to lead members through creating a painting together.

### Club Material Kits

Consider creating kits of meeting supplies that members can receive before the meeting. Organize a social distanced drop-off or pick-up of materials.

### How to Videos

There are ample how to videos to help teach skills available online. Share these with members either on a virtual meeting or as a resource for them to review outside of meeting time.

### Minimize Equipment Needed

Equipment can be a challenge when running meetings virtually. When selecting activities make sure the equipment needs are minimal or that you can ensure members can get access to the tools they need.
