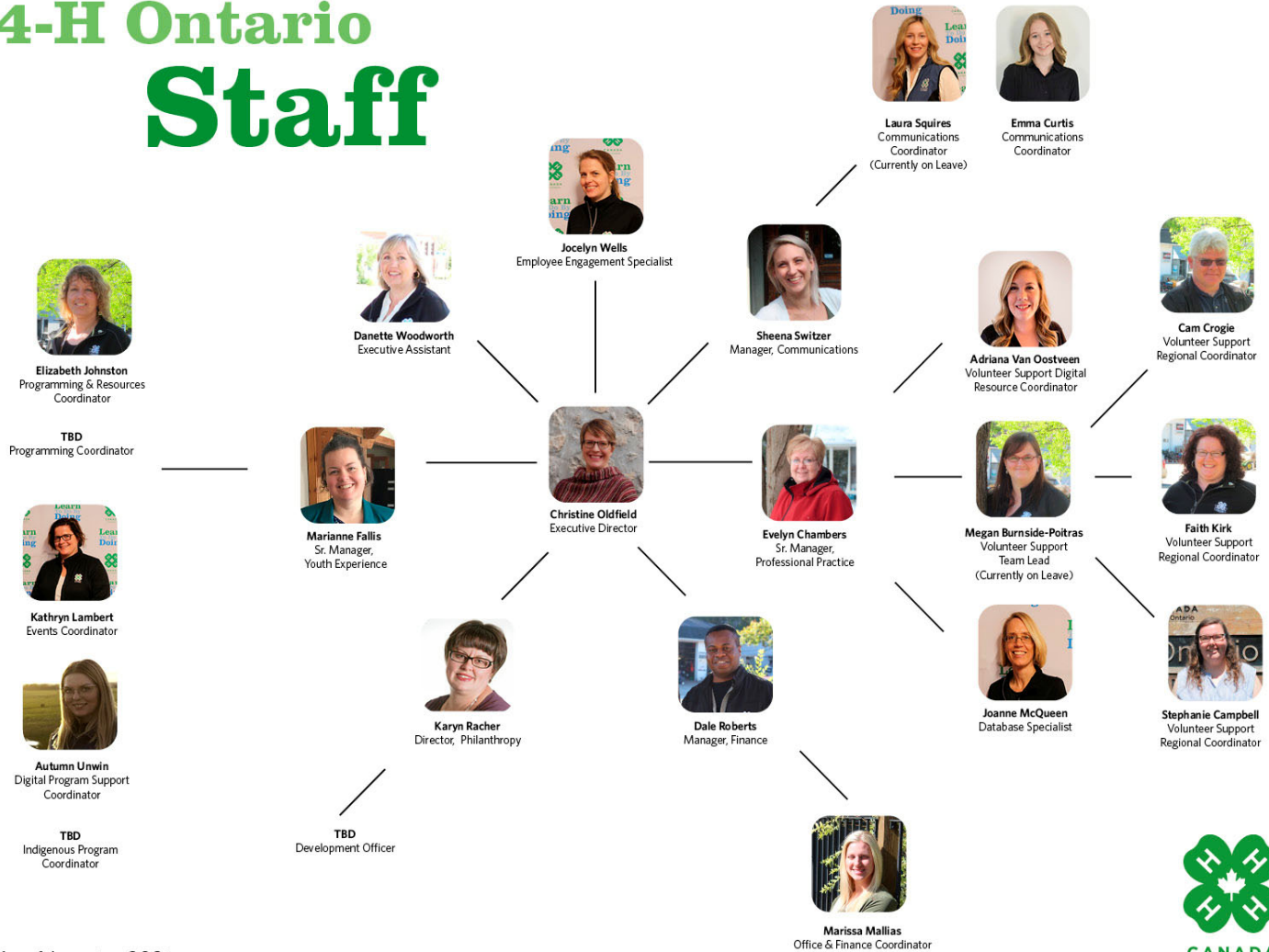

### Coordinator, Programming & Resources
