What is the Impact Conference?

The Impact Conference aims to educate, inspire and empower the future generation of leaders by providing them with the knowledge and resources necessary to pursue their chosen career path, and create a positive lasting impact within their club, community, country and world! Participants will learn about careers, volunteering and making a difference in their communities. The conference will be full of opportunities to learn, network and make lasting connections with like-minded individuals.

Who can attend?

Approximately 70 4-H participants from across the province, ages 14-21, will be nominated by their home association to attend this three-day conference. To be eligible to attend, delegates must have completed **at least 6 clubs** and be actively involved in 4-H and in the community.

When is the Impact Conference?

The Impact Conference takes place **Friday, October 18 to Sunday, October 20, 2024**. Delegates will arrive after dinner on Friday and depart before lunch on Sunday.

Where is it taking place?


The Impact Conference is taking place in Oakville, Ontario at the Holiday Inn Oakville Centre, located at 590 Argus Road, Oakville, L6J 3J3

Who books travel?

Participants are responsible for booking their own travel to and from the conference.

How do I get there?

-  From Toronto (driving): Take QEW-West to Trafalgar Road exit. Turn left onto Trafalgar Road and right onto Argus Road.
-  The Holiday Inn Oakville Centre is within walking distance from Oakville GO and VIA Rail Station.
 - If arriving from Pearson Airport: Take UP express to Union Station, and take Westbound Lakeshore GO Train to Oakville Station. The hotel is visible from the GO Station (2-minute walk).
 - If arriving via bus/train from Union Station: Take Westbound Lakeshore GO Train to Oakville GO Station. Hotel is visible from GO Station (2-minute walk).



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Is there a cost to attend?

Yes. The conference registration fee is \$225 (+HST) per delegate.

What is included in the cost?

Included in the \$225 fee is a hotel room for Friday and Saturday night and all meals (Saturday breakfast to Sunday breakfast).

What if I have a food allergy, can it be accommodated?

Where will we sleep? Can I request a roommate?

All conference delegates will be assigned a hotel room and one roommate (two beds per room). Rooms will be assigned based on age and gender, in accordance with 4-H Canada's youth supervision policy. You can request a roommate, however; we cannot guarantee that all requests can be accommodated.
