Write the 4-H Pledge. Describe how each line of the Pledge reflects your daily life. Explain how you would promote 4-H in your local school, in your community, or to someone who is unfamiliar with 4-H.

**Questions will periodically change if there are too many repeat applicants.

Must be 16 years of age or older as of January 1st in the year applying.

Have spent a minimum of 4 consecutive qualifying years in Norfolk 4-H.

Held executive positions at club level.

Assisted with Norfolk 4-H Association activities.

This award can only be won once.

If a member does not win, they may apply again in following years.
