

Youth Leader Project Criteria – To Receive Youth Leader Credit

Due Date: **November 21st** of year applying to an Awards Committee Member

Members must be between the ages of 15-21 (senior member) and be part of an active club in order to complete a youth leader project.

The Objectives of the Youth Leader Project are to give senior members an opportunity to:

- Put leadership into action at the club or association level
- Further develop communication, interpersonal and organizational skills
- Prepare to take on leadership roles
- Be a valuable resource to the 4-H program

General Requirements:

- Participate in a least 2/3 of your club meeting time
- Completing the project requirements to the satisfaction of the club leader
- Take part in an Achievement Program
- You may be called upon by committees with the Norfolk 4-H Association for assistance.

Complete the Youth Leader project book(s), signed by leaders and submit to a Norfolk 4-H Awards Committee member along with this criteria.
