

RALPH BRADLEY MEMORIAL BURSARY

The Drainage Superintendents Association of Ontario (DSAO) represents municipalities across Ontario in promoting and maintaining Municipal Drains primarily as they relate to the proper and efficient drainage of agricultural lands in the province.

Chapter 5, Niagara Region of the DSAO includes representatives from municipalities, agencies and engineering and environmental firms within the Regional Municipality of Niagara, Haldimand County, Norfolk County, Brant County, the City of Hamilton and Halton Region.

Since 1995, Chapter 5, Niagara Region has provided bursaries for programs ranging from veterinarian studies, environmental studies and agricultural business administration to cool climate oenology and viticulture. The Ralph Bradley Memorial Bursary, valued at **\$1000.00**, is awarded to a student from a municipality within the Chapter 5 area who will be furthering his/her education in an agricultural or water management related course.

Information about the bursary is sent to the Boards of Education in the Chapter 5 area for distribution to the secondary schools within their jurisdiction, as well as other organizations and the local media.

Students graduating in 2022 from a secondary school within the area of DSAO Chapter 5 are encouraged to contact the guidance department of their school and to request the guidelines and application form for the Ralph Bradley Memorial Bursary.
