

Impact Conference FAQ



What is the Impact Conference?

This conference aims to educate, inspire, and empower the future generation of leaders by providing them with the knowledge and resources necessary to pursue their chosen career path, and create a positive lasting impact within their club, community, country, and world.

Who can attend?

Approximately 70 4-H participants from across the province, aged 14-21, will be nominated by their home association to attend this two-day conference.

To be eligible to attend, delegates must have completed at **least 6 clubs** and be actively involved in 4-H and in their community.

When is the Impact Conference?

The Impact Conference takes place **Friday, October 13 to Sunday, October 15, 2023**. Delegates will arrive after dinner on Friday and depart before lunch on Sunday.



Where is it taking place?

Holiday Inn Oakville Centre, located at 590 Argus Road, Oakville, L6J 3J3

Who books travel?

Participants are responsible for booking their own travel to and from the conference.

How do I get there?

-  From Toronto (driving): Take QEW-West to Trafalgar Road Exit. Turn left onto Trafalgar Road, and right onto Argus Road.
-  The Holiday Inn Oakville Centre is within walking distance from Oakville GO and VIA Rail station.
 - If arriving from Pearson Airport: Take UP express to Union Station, and take Westbound Lakeshore GO Train to Oakville Station. The Hotel is visible from the GO station (2 minute walk).
 - If arriving by bus/train from Union Station: Take Westbound Lakeshore GO Train to Oakville Go station. Hotel is visible from GO Station (2 minute walk).

Is there a cost to attend?

Yes. The conference fee is \$200.00 per delegate to attend.

What is included in the cost?

Included in the \$200.00 fee is a hotel room for Friday and Saturday night, all meals (Saturday breakfast to Sunday breakfast).

What if I have a food allergy, can it be accommodated?
